HOW DOES THIS TRACK HELP YOU BUILD A DISCIPLE-MAKING COMMUNITY?

Engaging your church in the process of becoming more effective in making disciples will require Gospel courage. This track will help you sharpen your disciple making focus by intentionally assessing the purpose and effectiveness of what your church is doing and then to develop a change project move towards greater disciple making.

TRACK DESCRIPTION

The leadership challenge in today's church requires clear-eyed discernment into the current state of ministry, and the courage that comes from the Gospel to chart a path forward. This track teams you up with others on an adaptive leadership journey. Together you will see your ministry in new ways and embrace new options to lead forward. While the challenges of change look different in each church, increasing Gospel-rooted leadership will better position you to face *your* specific challenges.

OUTCOMES

- Discern your ministry's current state and any potential need for change. Also, you will implement a change project to address it.

- 4. Grow in personal Gospel awareness and how it empowers courageous leadership
- 5. Develop and carry out focused action steps to lead towards breakthrough
