

DEVELOPMENT AREA: PROPHETIC Practicing Prophetic Ministry: Healing

HOW DOES THIS TRACK HELP YOU BUILD A DISCIPLE-MAKING COMMUNITY?

As disciples of Jesus grow in hearing his voice, they increasingly do the things Jesus does – including healing. This track will provide imagination for the way healing can ground disciple making in the active presence of Jesus. The track will also give you tools and practice to make healthy healing ministry a part of your disciple-making pathway.

TRACK DESCRIPTION

Building on the foundation of our first Prophetic Track, "HEARING THE LEADERSHIP VOICE OF JESUS", this cohort offers practical application for prophetic ministry, specifically as related to healing ministry. The participants will explore and gain experience in healing ministry and leading their congregation and small groups in prophetic, healing ministry.

OUTCOMES

- 1. Biblical basis for understanding and practice of healing ministry.
- 2. Practice in safe, supportive environment
- 3. Be transformed through developing your Gospelroots and move in increasing Gospel impact
- 4. Lead church through growth in healing ministry
- 5. Identify safe friendships with 2-3 others so you can process what you hear Jesus saying

FORMAT

This track consists of a 3-month cohort experience and focus on one area of practical prophetic ministry, namely Healing:

- The cohorts meet once per month in person or via Zoom, engage in bi-weekly learning assignments, and participants interact monthly with a peer mentor.
- This 3-month cohort is one of three cohort modules on practicing prophetic ministry (see also Personal Prophetic Prayer and Deliverance). Participants will mature as you gain practice and constructive feedback in healing prayer.

SCHEDULE

April - June

- Week 1: Assigned reading/videos
- Week 2: Peer-mentor connection

- Week 3: Assigned reading/videos
- Week 4: Cohort (Zoom or live)
